Robena Coal PUBLIC NOTICE Pursuant to the Pennsylvania Clean Streams Law, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection Rules and Regulations, the Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act, and the Coal Refuse Disposal Control Act as amended, notice is hereby given that Consol Mining Company LLC, 1000 Consol Energy drive, Canonsburg, PA 15317 is making application to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection to revise existing Coal Refuse Disposal Permit No. 30733707 for the Robena Coal Refuse Disposal Area Facility. The proposed project is located in Monongahela Township, Greene County, Pennsylvania and is located on the Masontown, PA U.S. Geological Survey 7.5 minute topographic map. The proposed permit revision involves modifications to the existing Pond No. P-1 spillway system including the installation of an orifice in the existing outlet structure in order to dewater the pond and discontinue pumping of the pond water to the AMD Treatment Plant. All work will be performed within the existing coal refuse disposal area permitted area. The proposed revision will not add area to the existing permit area. The permit revision includes one new NPDES discharge point into Whiteley Creek. The proposed NPDES discharge point discharges flow from Pond No. P-1. NPDES Outfall 005 will be located in an existing ditch that outlets to Whiteley Creek approximately 800 feet upstream of its confluence with the Monongahela River. The permit area consists of 1449.0 acres. The facility is located in Morris Township, Greene County; northeast of the

existing Bailey Central Mine Complex in the valley located along SR 4014 (Booth School Road), 0.3 miles northeast of its intersection with Valley Church Road. Beginning at a point approximately 1,715 feet northeast of the Booth School Road/Valley Church Road intersection, the proposed permit area extends approximately 7,500 feet to the northeast; then approximately 3,550 feet northwest; then approximately 4,500 feet southwest; then 4,350 feet south to the starting point and in the valley located along Rush Run Road (formerly SR 4009), from its intersection with Valley Church Road (formerly SR 4013). Beginning near the Rush Run Road/Valley Church Road intersection, the proposed permit area extends approximately 10,000 feet to the northeast; with an average width of approximately 4,000 feet.
