Robena Coal PUBLIC NOTICE Pursuant to the Pennsylvania Clean Streams Law, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection Rules and Regulations, the Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act, and the Coal Refuse Disposal Control Act as amended, notice is hereby given that Consol Mining Company LLC, 1000 Consol Energy drive, Canonsburg, PA 15317 is making application to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection to revise existing Coal Refuse Disposal Permit No. 30733707 for the Robena Coal Refuse Disposal Area Facility. The proposed project is located in Monongahela Township, Greene County, Pennsylvania and is located on the Masontown, PA U.S. Geological Survey 7.5 minute topographic map. The proposed permit revision involves modifications to the existing Pond No. P-1 spillway system including the installation of an orifice in the existing outlet structure in order to dewater the pond and discontinue pumping of the pond water to the AMD Treatment Plant. All work will be performed within the existing coal refuse disposal area permitted area. The proposed revision will not add area to the existing permit area. The permit revision includes one new NPDES discharge point into Whiteley Creek. The proposed NPDES discharge point discharges flow from Pond No. P-1. NPDES Outfall

005 will be located in an existing ditch that outlets to Whiteley Creek approximately 800 feet upstream of its confluence with the Monongahela River. Harvey Mine PUBLIC NOTICE Pursuant to the Pennsylvania Clean Streams Law, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection Rules and Regulations, the Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act, and the Bituminous Mine Subsidence and Land Conservation Act as amended, notice is hereby given that Consol Pennsylvania Coal Company LLC, 1000 CONSOL Energy Drive, Canonsburg, PA 15317, has submitted an application to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection to revise Coal Mining Activity Permit No. 30121301 and related NPDES permit for the Harvey Mine. The proposed revision adds approximately 16.2 acres of surface permit area for the installation of the 4B Panel Degass Boreholes. The facilities will be located in Morris Township, Greene County, Pennsylvania and are located on the Rogersville and Waynesburg PA U.S. Geological Survey 7.5 minute topographic maps. The 4B-1a, 4B-1b, and 4B-2 Borehole permit area begins along the eastern side of Hopkins Run Road (T-478), approximately 400 feet south of its intersection with Simpson Chapel Road (T-618). It continues along an existing driveway to the southeast for approximately 0.3 miles where it then splits, with a section continuing to the northeast for approximately 0.2 miles and then to the southwest for 520 feet. The second section continues 0.2 miles southeast from the split, then 0.2 miles east, and 600 feet northwest. The permit varies in width between 50 feet and 300 feet and follows along existing driveways and trails for the majority of the length. The 4B-3 Borehole permit area is located off of the existing EQT Cooper Well pad access road, approximately 0.2 miles south of its intersection with Hopkins Run Road (T-478). It continues to the southwest for 250 feet and then to the southeast for approximately 870 feet, varying in width between 50 and 220 feet. The 4B-4 Borehole permit area is located off of the existing EQT F Iams Well Pad access road, approximately 0.5 miles south/southwest from its intersection with Hopkins Run Road (T-478). It continues south along the access road for 300 feet and extends to the west 200 feet. The proposed permit revision includes construction of five degass boreholes, access roads, soil stockpiles, and erosion and sedimentation control facilities. The application includes a request for variance to encroach within 100 feet of the right-of-way of Hopkins Run Road (T-478), beginning approximately 400 feet south of its intersection with Simpson Chapel Road (T-618) and continuing approximately 430 feet to the south. The variance is required for an access road and erosion and sedimentation control facilities. A stream variance request is proposed for work within 100 feet of a 65 foot section of UNT 40542-R3d to Browns Creek at its headwaters, located approximately 2120 feet west and 700 feet north of the intersection of Ross School Road (T-617) and Hopkins Run Road (T-478). The stream variance is required for an access road for the 4B-3 Borehole facility and installation of erosion and sedimentation control facilities. Titus Mine PUBLIC NOTICE Notice is hereby given that Dana Mining Company of PA, LLC, 966 Crafts Run Road, Maidsville, WV 26541, has requested bond release for surface site to a deep mine Permit No. 30841314 pursuant to the Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act.
