LAND RECYCLING AND ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION

Mojo Compressor Station, Primary Facility ID # **862141**, 1415 Amity Ridge Road, Washington, PA 15311, Amwell Township, **Washington County**. SE Technologies, LLC, 500 Mosites Way, Pittsburgh, PA 15215 on behalf of Equitrans Midstream, 2200 Energy Drive, Canonsburg, PA 15317, submitted a Notice of Intent to Remediate. On September 13, 2022, SE Technologies, LLC (SET—Environmental Consultant) and Equitrans mobilized to the site to collect confirmatory soil samples. The well pad material was excavated from a 5 ft x 5 ft area to a depth of 27 inches to expose the surface of the underlying fine-grained soil. Eight confirmatory samples were collected from the bottom excavation surface from randomly selected locations for laboratory analysis of EG. Laboratory results of the soil samples showed that EG concentrations were below detection levels. Equitrans will seek Act 2 Liability Protection under the residential Statewide health standard for soil. Future use of the property will continue as a natural gas compressor station into the foreseeable future. The Notice of Intent to Remediate was published in *Observer-Reporter* on October 24, 2022. DETERMINATION OF APPLICABILITY FOR RESIDUAL WASTE GENERAL PERMITS

Latitude: 40.423919°, Longitude: -80.352728°. Application received: May 26, 2022. Issued: October 21, 2022. ETC Northeast Field Services, LLC is proposing to remediate a slope failure near Station 2087+50 of the Revolution natural gas pipeline. The project requires permanent impacts to streams and wetlands due to reconstruction of the slope with engineered soil fill and a riprap fill foundation key. The slope will be reconstructed to approximate preexisting grades. Wetland mitigation is proposed at the already constructed Upper Cross Creek Restoration Area. The project is located within the Clinton USGS 7 1/2 Minute Quadrangle Map.

ACTIVE AND ABANDONED MINE OPERATIONS

Notice is hereby given the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) District Mining Operations, has received two (2) major modification applications from Tunnel Ridge, LLC, permit number 63091301 to amend the existing permit.

The applications are to revise the existing Coal Mining Activities Permit (CMAP) underground mining acreage and the subsidence control plan area to (1) add 1,451.25 acres for development only mining in Donegal, West and East Finely Townships and (2) revise 1,155.75 acres from development only mining to longwall mining in Donegal Township. The existing mine is located within Donegal Township in Washington County.

California District Mining office has received requests for an informal public conference (IPC) concerning these major modification applications. In an effort to make this proceeding available to as many interested stakeholders as possible, this IPC is being held virtually on Wednesday, December 7, 2022 and will commence at 6:00 p.m.

DEP staff will be available to answer general questions on the permit application.

The California District Mining Office will accept additional written comments from participants of the IPC two (2) weeks after the date of the proceeding until December 21, 2022.
