Description of Proposed Activity: The application is for a new NPDES permit for a new discharge of treated sewage.

The receiving stream(s), Unnamed Tributary to Mingo Creek (HQ—TSF), is located in State Water Plan watershed 19-C and is classified for High Quality Waters—Trout Stocking, aquatic life, water supply and recreation. The discharge is not expected to affect public water supplies.

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the Pennsylvania Clean Streams Law, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection Rules and Regulations, the Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act, and the Bituminous Mine Subsidence and Land Conservation Act as amended, notice is hereby given that Consol Pennsylvania Coal Company LLC, 275 Technology Drive, Suite 101, Canonsburg, PA 15317, has submitted an application to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection to revise Coal Mining Activity Permit No. 30841316 and related NPDES permit for the Bailey Mine.

The proposed revision adds approximately 4.3 acres of surface permit area for the installation of the 11L-5 Degas Borehole. The facility will be located in Aleppo Township, Greene County, Pennsylvania and is located on the New Freeport, PA U.S. Geological Survey 7.5 minute topographic map. The permit area begins at an existing driveway off of the northern side of SR 3018 (Behm Road), approximately 0.2 miles west of its intersection with Blacks Creek Road (T-356). It follows along the existing driveway for approximately 1900 feet, at a width of 50 feet. It then continues to the northeast for approximately 400 feet, varying in width between 50 and 300 feet. The proposed permit revision includes construction of a degas borehole, access road, soil stockpile, and erosion and sedimentation control facilities.

The application includes a request for variance to encroach within 100 feet of the right-of-way of SR 3018 (Behm Road), approximately 0.15 miles west of its intersection with Blacks Creek Road (T-356) and continuing 235 feet to the northwest. The road variance is required for site access.

Stream variance requests are proposed for work within 100 feet of the following two streams: UNT 32568C to Blacks Creek beginning at its culvert under SR 3018 (Behm Road), located approximately 0.2 miles west of the intersection of SR 3018 and Blacks Creek Road and continuing 715 feet upstream, to the northeast; and a 55 foot section of UNT 32568C-3 to Blacks Creek, located at its headwaters approximately 1050 feet north and 630 feet west of the intersection of SR 3018 and Blacks Creek Road. The stream variances are required for site access.

Written comments, objections, or a request for an informal conference may be submitted to the Department of Environmental Protection, District Mining Operations, at the above address, no later than thirty (30) days following the final publication date of this notice.

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
