Pursuant to the PENNSYLVANIA CLEAN STREAMS LAW, the PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION Rules and Regulations, the SURFACE MINING CONSERVATION and RECLAMATION ACT, and the BITUMINOUS MINE SUBSIDENCE and LAND CONSERVATION ACT as amended, notice is hereby given that Tunnel Ridge, LLC, doing business at 184 Schoolhouse Road, Triadelphia, WV 26059, has made application to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection to revise the Tunnel Ridge Mine permit (CMAP 63091301) and related NPDES permit. The application proposes 8.5 acres of surface permit area for the construction of the Park Road Bleeder Site located in East Finley Township, Washington County, PA. The proposed bleeder site area is located on the northeast side of Park Road (T-412) approximately 110 feet southeast of the intersection of Burnsville Ridge Road (SR 3029) and Park Road (T-412). The site is located on the Claysville, PA 7 1/2 `USGS map.

A road variance for Park Road (T-412) begins at a point approximately 110 feet southeast of the intersection of Burnsville Ridge Road (SR 3029) and Park Road (T-412), traveling approximately 1,060 feet along the northeast side of Park Road for the installation of erosion & sediment controls and grading of the proposed shaft pad.

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the Pennsylvania Clean Streams Law, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection Rules and Regulations, the Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act, and the Bituminous Mine Subsidence and Land Conservation Act as amended, notice is hereby given that Consol Pennsylvania Coal Company LLC, 275 Technology Drive, Suite 101, Canonsburg, PA 15317, has submitted an application to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection to revise Coal Mining Activity Permit No. 30841316 and related NPDES permit for the Bailey Mine.

The proposed revision adds approximately 4.3 acres of surface permit area for the installation of the 11L-5 Degas Borehole. The facility will be located in Aleppo Township, Greene County, Pennsylvania and is located on the New Freeport, PA U.S. Geological Survey 7.5 minute topographic map. The permit area begins at an existing driveway off of the northern side of SR 3018 (Behm Road), approximately 0.2 miles west of its intersection with Blacks Creek Road (T-356). It follows along the existing driveway for approximately 1900 feet, at a width of 50 feet. It then continues to the northeast for approximately 400 feet, varying in width between 50 and 300 feet. The proposed permit revision includes construction of a degas borehole, access road, soil stockpile, and erosion and sedimentation control facilities.

The application includes a request for variance to encroach within 100 feet of the right-of-way of SR 3018 (Behm Road), approximately 0.15 miles west of its intersection with Blacks Creek Road (T-356) and continuing 235 feet to the northwest. The road variance is required for site access.

Stream variance requests are proposed for work within 100 feet of the following two streams: UNT 32568C to Blacks Creek beginning at its culvert under SR 3018 (Behm Road), located approximately 0.2 miles west of the intersection of SR 3018 and Blacks Creek Road and continuing 715 feet upstream, to the northeast; and a 55 foot section of UNT 32568C-3 to Blacks Creek, located at its headwaters approximately 1050 feet north and 630 feet west of the intersection of SR 3018 and Blacks Creek Road. The stream variances are required for site access.
