PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the Pennsylvania Clean Streams Law, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection Rules and Regulations, the Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act, and the Bituminous Mine Subsidence and Land Conservation Act as amended, notice is hereby given that Consol Pennsylvania Coal Company LLC, 275 Technology Drive, Suite 101, Canonsburg, PA 15317, has submitted an application to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection to revise Coal Mining Activity Permit No. 30841316 and related NPDES permit for the Bailey Mine.

The proposed revision adds approximately 9.4 acres of surface permit area for the installation of the 12L-3, 12L-4, & 12L-5 Degas Boreholes. The facilities will be located in Aleppo Township, Greene County, Pennsylvania and are located on the New Freeport, PA U.S. Geological Survey 7.5 minute topographic map. The permit area begins off Blacks Creek Road (T-356) approximately 0.2 miles northwest of its intersection with Higbee Road (T-447). It extends 1250 feet northeast and then splits. One portion extends 1470 feet southeast, varying in width between 80 and 240 feet for the 12L-3 Borehole. The other portion extends 425 feet northwest, varying in width between 250 and 400 feet for the

12L-4 Borehole. The 12L-5 Borehole permit boundary is located along the southwest side of Blacks Creek Road, beginning approximately 310 feet south from its intersection with SR 3018 (Behm Road). It continues along the road for 310 feet to the southeast and varies in width between 50 and 150 feet. The proposed permit revision includes construction of three degas boreholes, access roads, soil stockpiles, and erosion and sedimentation control facilities.

The application includes a request for variance to encroach within 100 feet of the right-of-way of Blacks Creek Road (T-356) at two locations. The first begins 0.2 miles northwest of its intersection with Higbee Road (T-447) and continues 210 feet to the northwest, and the second begins 310 feet south of its intersection with SR 3018 (Behm Road) and continues 310 feet to the southeast. The road variances are required for site access and erosion and sedimentation controls for the 12L-3 and 12L-4 borehole facilities and access, the borehole pad, borehole installation, and erosion and sedimentation controls for the 12L-5 borehole.

Stream variance requests are proposed for work within 100 feet of two streams: Blacks Creek (32568) beginning 370 feet south and 175 feet west of the intersection of Blacks Creek Road (T-356) and SR 3018 (Behm Road) and continuing upstream 360 feet southeast; and a 70-foot section of variance for UNT 32568I to Blacks Creek at its culvert under Blacks Creek Road (T-356) located approximately 0.2 miles northwest of the intersection with Higbee Road (T-447) and continuing upstream in a northeasterly direction. The stream variances are required for site access, borehole pad construction, and erosion and sediment control facility installation.

Pursuant to the "Noncoal Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act" and the "Clean Streams Law" notice is hereby given that Neiswonger Construction, Inc., 17592 Route 322, Strattanville, PA 16258 has made application to the Pennsylvania Department of

Environmental Protection (DEP) for a permit to conduct noncoal underground and surface mining activities in Deemston Borough, Washington County. The operation proposed would encompass and replace the applicant's existing surface mine permit. The application includes a request for authorization to discharge under an individual NPDES permit and to conduct blasting activities.

The proposed 359.1 acre Maggie Lynn Underground Mine is located on both sides of SR 2041 (Morey Road) beginning at its intersection with Pump Station Road and extending northward approximately 3,000 feet, on the north side of Pump Station Road beginning at its intersection with SR 2041 and extending toward the southwest approximately 3,000 feet, and on the east side of Tenmile Creek beginning at the Tenmile Creek bridge on Pump Station Road and extending toward the north approximately 4,200 feet as shown on the Ellsworth, PA and the Mather, PA 7.5 minute USGS topographic maps on the properties of John Kosky Contracting Inc. and Clyde Holding, Inc. Within the 359.1-acre permit boundary, surface activities are proposed to be conducted on 110.1 acres, with underground noncoal mining of 256.6 acres. The receiving streams for this proposed permit area are Tenmile Creek (TSF), and unnamed tributaries to Tenmile Creek.

Consistent with previous surface mining at this site, mining activities are proposed with 100 feet of the following stream sections: 1- Tenmile Creek beginning approximately 2,360 feet upstream from the Pump Station Road Bridge on the east side of the stream and extending upstream approximately 1,660 feet. 2- Unnamed tributary D to Tenmile Creek located approximately 540 feet due west of Morey Road, extending approximately 150' long for placement of fill and a haul road stream crossing. 3- Unnamed tributary E South Branch to Tenmile Creek beginning approximately 700 upstream from its confluence with Unnamed Tributary E and extends upstream approximately 370 feet for the construction and maintenance of a haul road. 4- Unnamed tributary E to Tenmile Creek beginning approximately 1,860 upstream from its confluence with Tenmile Creek and extends upstream approximately 400 feet for placement of fill and a haul road stream crossing. 5- Unnamed tributary E to Tenmile Creek beginning approximately 1,400 feet upstream from the stream's confluence with Tenmile Creek and extends upstream approximately 400 feet for the purpose of relocating and reconstruction of the stream.
