Township, Washington County, Pittsburgh USACE District (40.144500, -80.263100), Sub-Basin 20F (Chartiers Creek), Quad Name: West Washington. The applicant proposes to construct, operate, and maintain a second permanent floating intake within Washington Reservoir No. 3, a designated High Quality Warm Water Fishery in North Franklin Township, Washington County. The intake is proposed in order to meet the conservation release requirements stated in the approved source water management plan and meet release rate requirements under as stated in Pa. Code § 105.113(c). The intake will consist of one (1) 6-foot-long by 12-inch diameter cylinder with a mesh screen of less than 3/16-inch and pumping rate will have a velocity of less than 0.5 ft/sec. The intake will be elevated a minimum of 2 feet above the bottom of the reservoir and will be attached to an existing pump and metering facility via one (1) 110 LF 3-inch diameter DR11 polyethylene line (flexible hose). The discharge of the pump will be a 4-inch diameter DR11 aboveground polyethylene line routed from the pump to an outfall location at the reservoir spillway. Project proposes 0.006 acre of permanent direct reservoir and floodway impacts for the permanent floating intake, flexible hose, and aboveground waterline and outfall at reservoir spillway. Additionally, project is permitting one (1) General Permit 5 crossing for the installation of the aboveground waterline, which temporarily impacted 0.014 acre of Palustrine Emergent wetland (Wetland W003).
