FEDERAL WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ACT SECTION 401

E6307225-001. Markwest Liberty Midstream & Resources, LLC, 4600 Barry Ct., Suite 500, Canonsburg, PA 15317, North Fayette Township, Robinson Township, Allegheny County, Washington County. U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Pittsburgh District. The applicant proposes to install a 20-inch diameter steel natural gas gathering pipeline approximately 24,000 feet in length, within a 100-foot right-of-way. Installation of the pipeline and associated access road will result in 0.01 acre temporary direct, 0.80 acre temporary indirect, and 0.01 acre permanent indirect impacts to three streams designated as Warm Water Fishery. One perennial named stream—North Branch Robinson Run and two ephemeral unnamed tributaries to Robinson Run will experience permanent and temporary impacts to both stream and floodway, while an unnamed ephemeral tributary to North Branch Robinson Run will incur only temporary floodway impacts. Pipeline installation by conventional bore under a PFO wetland will result in 0.02 acre temporary indirect impacts. The aquatic resource impacts are not eligible for Chapter 105 General Permits because one of the stream crossings is located on a property containing part of the Montour Trail, an eligible historic district. Proposed project impacts include temporary access road installation, clearing and grubbing within the ROW, open trenching, boring, construction of the permanent surface site and associated stormwater management BMPs, and site restoration.
