Notice is hereby given that **Duquesne Light Company (DLC)** intends to prepare a revision to the 1995 Facility Closure Plan. The modifications to the Closure Plan include the installation of pipelines designed to convey leachate generated from the closed Elrama Ash Disposal Facility, formerly associated with the Elrama Generating Station, to existing state and municipal drainage infrastructure located along Route 837. These drainage systems also receive surface water runoff from the Norfolk Southern Rail Yard before ultimately discharging into the Monongahela River. Pursuant to the Pennsylvania Clean Streams Law, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection Rules and Regulations, the Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act, and the Bituminous Mine Subsidence and Land Conservation Act as amended, notice is hereby given that Consol Pennsylvania Coal Company LLC, 275 Technology Drive, Suite 101, Canonsburg, PA 15317, has submitted an application to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection to revise Coal Mining Activity Permit No. 30121301 for the Harvey Mine.

The proposed revision adds approximately 11.4 acres of surface permit area for the installation of the 2N Panel Degas Boreholes. The facilities will be located in Center Township, Greene County, Pennsylvania and are located on the Rogersville, PA U.S. Geological Survey 7.5 minute topographic map. The 2N-1 borehole permit begins off of the existing 1N Bleeder permit area off of Boulder Road. It starts at a point 1080 feet north and 1120 feet east of the access road entrance off of Boulder Road (T-485). It continues approximately 500 feet south and varies in width between 20 and 140 feet. The 2N-2 and 2N-3 boreholes permit area begins off of the Equitrans Europa Compressor Station access road, approximately 0.3 miles northeast of the intersection with SR 4017 (West Run Road). The permit area extends approximately 1135 feet south where it splits, continuing 580 feet south for the 2N-3 borehole. From the split, it also continues 1350 feet east and then 930 feet south, varying in width between 75 feet and 330 feet for the 2N-2 borehole. The proposed permit revision includes construction of three degas boreholes, access roads, soil stockpiles, and erosion and sedimentation control facilities.

In accordance with 25 Pa. Code 271.141(a), notice is hereby given that Casella Mid-Atlantic, LLC is submitting an application to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP) for the reissuance of an existing Solid Waste Permit for the Greene County Transfer Facility (Permit No. 101718), located at 108 Bald Hill Road in Mount Morris, PA. The permit for this facility is currently held by RGL, Inc. dba Mountain State Waste. PADEP requires municipal waste transfer facilities to reissue previously approved permits once facility ownership changes. The application is being submitted to allow for the continued operation of the existing facility which includes the receipt of up to 300 tons of solid waste per day. A recycling drop-off center is also provided for local community residents. Casella Mid-Atlantic, LLC proposes no expansion, design modification, or increase in capacity for the existing facility as part of the application. The permit application will be submitted to the PADEP, host municipality, and host county. Copies of the application and supporting documentation will be available for public inspection and comments at the PADEP SW Regional Office located at 400 Waterfront Drive, Pittsburgh, PA 15222 during normal business hours. Written comments regarding the application by the public may be submitted to PADEP during the permit review process. Perry Township and Greene County may submit comments to the PADEP within 60 days of receipt of the application, recommending conditions or revision to the application with specific reasons described in the comments.
