Pursuant to the Pennsylvania Clean Streams Law, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection Rules and Regulations, the Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act, and the Bituminous Mine Subsidence and Land Conservation Act as amended, notice is hereby given that Consol Pennsylvania Coal Company LLC, 275 Technology Drive, Suite 101, Canonsburg, PA 15317, has submitted an application to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection to revise Coal Mining Activity Permit No. 30841316 for the Bailey Mine.

The proposed revision adds approximately 13.2 acres of surface permit area for the installation of the 1M Panel Degas Boreholes. The facilities will be located in Center and Ricchhill Townships, Greene County, Pennsylvania and are located on the Rogersville and Wind Ridge, PA U.S. Geological Survey 7.5 minute topographic maps. The 1M-2 borehole permit area begins along Pettit Road (T-527) at the CNX Gas well GH58 Pad access road entrance. It continues along the existing access road to the south and southeast for approximately 1450 feet and varies in width between 40 and 290 feet. The 1M-3 borehole permit area begins off of Pettit Road, 0.6 miles northeast of its intersection with Shelleby Road (T-394). It continues to the northwest 820 feet and then to the north 1080 feet, varying in width between 60 feet and 270 feet. The 1M-4 borehole permit area begins along Jones Road, 0.2 miles east of its intersection with SR

3007 (Whitethorn Run Road) and continues along the road 535 feet to the east. It extends to the south of the road, varying in width between 100 and 210 feet. The proposed permit revision includes construction of four degas boreholes, access roads, soil stockpiles, and erosion and sedimentation control facilities. The 1M-1 borehole is located within existing permit areas.

The application includes a request for variance to encroach within 100 feet of the right-of-way of the following two public roads: Jones Road (T-533) beginning approximately 0.2 miles east of its intersection with Whitethorn Run Road (SR 3007) and continuing approximately 535 feet west; and Pettit Road (T-527) in two locations the first beginning approximately 0.6 miles northeast of its intersection with Shelleby Road (T-394) and continuing approximately 105 feet northeast, and the second beginning 1.3 miles northeast of its intersection with Shelleby Road and continuing approximately 190 feet southeast. The road variances are required for site access, pad construction, borehole installation, a soil stockpile, and erosion and sedimentation controls for the borehole facilities.

Stream variance requests are proposed for work within 100 feet of the following seven streams: UNT 40706D to Claylick Run, beginning at a point 600 feet east and 980 feet south of the CNX Gas well GH58 pad access road entrance off of Pettit Road and continuing downstream 65 feet in a westerly direction; UNT 40706F to Claylick Run, beginning at its headwaters 75 feet east and 870 feet south of the CNX Gas well GH58 pad access road entrance off of Pettit Road and continuing downstream 60 feet in a southwesterly direction; UNT 40706 to Claylick Run, beginning at a point 140 feet west and 865 feet south of the CNX Gas well GH58 pad access road entrance off of Pettit Road and continuing downstream 155 feet in a westerly direction; UNT 40706H to Claylick Run, beginning at a point 145 feet west and 445 feet south of the CNX Gas well GH58 pad access road entrance off of Pettit Road and continuing downstream 405 feet in a southerly direction; UNT 32616U to Whitethorn Run, beginning approximately 815 feet east of the intersection of Jones Road (T-533) and SR 3007 (Whitethorn Run Road) and continuing 585 feet upstream, to the east; UNT 32616U-1 to Whitethorn Run, located at its culvert under Jones Road, approximately 1040 feet east of its intersection with SR 3007, and continuing upstream approximately 265 feet in a southerly direction; and UNT 32616U-2 to Whitethorn Run, beginning at its confluence with 32616U-1 approximately 60 feet upstream of the culvert under Jones Road and continuing upstream for 290 feet in a southerly direction. The stream variances are required for the 1M-2 and 1M-4 facilities including borehole pad construction, a topsoil stockpile, access to the sites including stream crossings, and erosion and sedimentation controls.
